- Visitors will be transported from the Ruby Welcome Center to the Jamboree via motor coach. No personal vehicles allowed.
- Parking will be provided at the Welcome Center.

Visitor movement for general day visitors while on the Jamboree site will be limited to Summit Center.

Areas accessible to day visitors include:

- Centro Mondial, World Point, and the Global Development Village
- Main retail store, food and snack bars, exhibits, and Consol Energy Bridge
- Day visitors will be able to observe but not participate in the Boulder Cove climbing, Challenge Course events, Skate Board Plaza, Mountain Biking, Climbing, Zip lining and BMX riding activities.
- Day visitors will not be allowed in sub camps or activities outside the Summit Center

• Proposed fee schedule:

Adult Single Day (over 14 years old)\$50.00 USDYouth Single Day (ages 6 to 13)\$25.00 USDYouth under age 6 and under – no fee\$25.00 USD

- Only single day tickets will be sold no multi-day options
- Online advanced ticket sales will be emphasized and encouraged. Tickets will be sold at the Welcome Center on visitor days.
- Visitors will need to complete the Summit Risk Acknowledgement Form
- Advanced ticket sales and up-to-date day visitor information will be located on the day visitor webpage

To ensure the safety of jamboree participants, staff and the visitors, the following items will be prohibited:

Large Backpacks: not to exceed: 13" (33 cm) x 13" x 11" (28 cm) inches (16 quarts/15 liters)

Coolers

Picnic Baskets

Glass bottles

Firearms

Alcohol

Pets (Guide or service dogs with appropriate documentation are acceptable) Illegal Substances

Knives (blades exceeding 3.5 inches (8.9 cm))

Smoking is prohibited on motor coaches and at the Jamboree

Bag screening will take place prior to boarding the motor coach to the Summit Center
