



#### • Commitment to SBR's 8 pillars of sustainable jamboree planning:



- **1. Design** for Scouts, not cars or trucks.
- 2. Minimize impacts to areas that have already been disturbed.
- **3. Generate** on-site renewable energy.
- **4. Recycle** water, clean it passively, and return it to the watershed.
- 5. Conserve energy and water.
- 6. Choose materials that are healthy for people and the environment.
- 7. Treat wastes as resources and find ways to use and recover them.
- 8. Measure the progress by these pillars.

- Plans to provide web-based training to IST and participants in advance to enable to be aware of and adopt sustainability practices
