## SPECIAL GUESTS AND HOSTING A RECEPTION AT THE JAMBOREE

## **INVITING SPECIAL GUESTS**

- Special Guests are invited individuals who come to see the World Scout Jamboree in action
- Registration is now open to allow NSOs to invite Special Guests to visit the World Jamboree
- All invited Special Guests must be registered using the Special Guest credentialing and registration system
- NSOs and other entities wishing to invite Special Guests must email wsj2019.questservices@gmail.com
  - o Provide the names of the Special Guests you wish to invite
  - o Request an individual registration code
- Further registration information will be provided once an NSO receives registration codes
  - Each NSO will receive 2 complimentary codes. Additional codes are available at a cost of \$80 (USD), which includes the day visitor fee, special transportation, hosting in the Special Guest area, tours of the Jamboree's Centro Mondial, and provision of beverages and snacks
  - Upon confirmation of the registration, the Guest Services team will provide further information to facilitate the arrival and departure to and from the Jamboree site
- 2019 WSJ Guest Services will host attending Special Guests upon arrival at Ruby Welcome Center

## **HOSTING A RECEPTION AT THE JAMBOREE**

- Reservations to host a reception or event are now possible and can be requested <u>here</u>
- For scheduled receptions, the 2019 WSJ provides:
  - An appropriately-sized location (free)
  - AV equipment, as available (projector, microphone, sound system, screen) (free)
  - Catering (required, cost is involved)
  - Support with configuration of tables, chairs, stage, etc. may be arranged in advance, based on availability and timeliness of the request (free)
- Receptions may be scheduled any time on a Jamboree day, including show days, and are typically reserved for 45/60 minutes per reception
- Special requests may be considered
- Reception locations
  - Guest Services will provide 4 locations
    - Three (3) are in the Legacy Point area
    - One (1) is in the World Point area
  - o All will be reserved on a first-come, first-serve basis
- The reservation form contains a link to the catering order form
  - There are various food and beverage options
  - Please note that all receptions **MUST** order catering food using this link
- Other notes
  - No alcohol may be served at receptions
  - Any food items brought from outside the USA must comply with US Food and Health Department regulations, and must be pre-approved by the Jamboree Food Team management
