

To take the World Scouting Jamboree training, follow this procedure


Please take the time to read this document thoroughly for the optimal training experience.

NOTE: All training should be taken using the latest version of the Chrome browser. This includes laptops, tablets and phones and all IOS based devices. This is very important that you use Chrome or you will experience problems streaming the content.

NOTE: To register for the training you will need your WSJ Registration Number. Look it up before you start the registration process. To be clear, this is the personal registration number that you received in an email when registering. It is NOT your contingent number. It is your unique number. It will be in this format: XXX-XXXXXX-XXXX where X is a number.

Open the link: <https://captivateprime.adobe.com/eplogin?groupid=8899&accesskey=e1mmgh01nur5c> using a Chrome browser.

Which will take you to a page that looks like this so that you can self-register for the training:

We do not monitor password strength so you can use anything. But we do recommend a strong password that cannot be hacked. Fill out the fields and click the blue Register button. Which will take you to the next screen. That will look like this:

Your email has to be verified. Please check your inbox for a Welcome mail with a verification link. Once your email has been verified, you will be logged into the account.

Check your email for the message that will have the Subject “Welcome to Adobe Captivate Prime”

Which when opened looks like this:

Open your email and click on the “[here](#)” link within the email message. When you click on the link it will ask you to enter your registration code number as shown below.

NOTE: VERY IMPORTANT!! Your completion of all training is tracked by your personal registration number. Please make sure it is correct or your entry to the jamboree could be delayed. Copy and Paste is highly recommended to ensure the correct number with no typos.




NOTE: To facilitate easy reentry to the training system, you should bookmark this page and let Google store your password.

NOTE: Click remember me to make future logins easier.

Once logged in you will see a page that looks like this:



You can set the interface language for the learning management system by clicking on the down arrow by the person graphic and selecting “Profile Settings”



That will bring up a box like this. Use the down arrow next to the “Interface Language” box to select from a number of language options. And select your Time zone as well.

NOTE: This does not change the language of the content, only the interface. You must choose from the appropriate course selection for your choice of English, French, or Spanish.



Select the course that you would like to take and click on Explore.


Depending on which course you select you will see the following:

Safe from Harm


Click on Safe from Harm Certification course.




This screen will appear:

Click on the blue Start box or start the training module by clicking on the title of the first course which will then look something like this:




Click on the arrow in the circle to start the training.


NOTE: You will see a progress bar at the bottom of the page. It is the blue bar with a slider button.

NOTE: The forward button has been deactivated. You must complete the training by listening to each module and completing the Case Study or Learning Checks.




